	education, training and support services to succeed in the labor market and to

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	WIOA supersedes the titles I and II of the Workforce Investment Act of 1998, and
	amends the Wagner-Peyser Act, and the Rehabilitation Act of 1973. In general,
	the Act takes effect on July 1, 2015, the first full program year after enactment.
Policy:	All new participant eligibility determinations must be made under the WIOA
_ 5110 / 1	framework and must follow all WIOA requirements. Participants enrolled on or
	after July 1, 2015 may only access services allowable under WIOA.

Local Workforce Boards, in consultation with the chief elected officials, must establish WIOA Title I eligibility policies and procedures consistent with the guidance provided herein.
