**Subject:** **WISPR Performance & Reporting System Training**

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**Purpose:** To notify Local Workforce Investment Boards, One-Stop Career Center Operators and other local workforce investment partners of the opportunity to attend training sessions intended to introduce and clarify the reporting changes contained in the Workforce Investment Streamlined Performance Reporting (WISPR) System.

**Background:** On May 1, 2007, the U.S. Department of Labor Employment and Training Administration (ETA) issued Training and Employment Notice No. 30-06 ETA Performance & Reporting Summits 2007 (attached). ETA has scheduled three, 3-day training summits specifically geared to workforce system professionals who work at the local level. The summits will cover program reporting and performance management under WIA (Adult, Youth and Dislocated Worker), Wagner-Peyser, VETS, and the Trade Act.
