At this public meeting DCR will present the Wompatuck State Park Circulation Master Plan and the proposed recommendations and action items. The primary goal of the circulation master plan is to develop a comprehensive guide with the short- and long-term trail circulation recommendations that enhance connectivity to recreational opportunities while protecting environmentally and culturally sensitive areas. This meeting follows two (2) prior public engagement sessions hosted on May 16<sup>th</sup>, 2023 and October 3, 2023.

The public will be invited to ask questions on the presentation by unmuting their microphones, or the chat functionality that will be available through the virtual participation platform.
