OFF THE BEATEN PATH HIKE, 1:30 p.m.-3:00 p.m.

Meet at the Transfer Station; take Union St. 1.5 miles past the Park Visitor Center, to the intersection with Beechwood St. Bathrooms are available at the Visitor Center, but not at the Transfer Station.
