DECISION

M & S Entertainment, Inc. dba Club Venue (the "Licensee") holds an all alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on September 21, 2010 regarding an alleged violation of M.G.L. c.138, §34 (1 count). Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation detailed in Investigator Jan Kujawski's Report regarding the violations that occurred on May 15, 2010.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts;
2. Investigator Jan Kujawski's Report; and
3. Copy of False Brazilian License.

There is one (1) tape of this hearing.

Facts

1. On, May 15, 2010 at approximately 12:35 a.m., Commission Investigators investigated the business operation of M & S Entertainment, Inc. dba Club Venue.
2. Investigators observed a young female patron with an alcoholic beverage.
3. Investigators identified themselves and asked her for identification.
4. Lais Pereira, age 19, first gave Investigators her false Brazilian Identification and then her real passport.
5. Ms. Pereira informed the investigators that the doorman carded her but the bartender did not.

Conclusion

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated M.G.L. c.138, §34. The Commission **suspends the license for three (3) days of which three (3) days will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.**
