DECISION

Macattacks LLC dba Johnny Mac's Bar and Grille ("The Licensee") holds an all alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission ("The Commission") scheduled a hearing on December 07, 2010 regarding an alleged violation M.G.L. c.138, §34C. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the facts detailed in the Investigator Brad Doyle's report regarding the violations that occurred on September 18, 2010.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Stipulation of Facts;
2. Investigator Brad Doyle's Report; and
3. RMV Information Sheet.

There is one (1) tape of this hearing.

FACTS

1. On September 18, 2010 Investigators Doyle, Kujawski, Keefe and Bailey, along with the Worcester Police Department, investigated the business operation of Macattacks LLC dba Johnny Mac's Bar and Grille to determine the manner in which their business is conducted.
2. Upon entering the premises, the Investigators observed four (4) youthful looking individuals in possession of what appeared to be alcoholic beverages.
3. The Investigators identified themselves to the female patrons and asked for identification.
4. It was determined that one individual was under twenty-one (21) years of age and was in possession of an alcoholic beverage.

5. The female patron stated she was not asked for identification upon entering the premises.
6. Investigator Doyle spoke with the bartender and the manager on duty and informed them of the violation.
7. An administrative review was performed by the Commission. The Licensee has been in business for two (2) years and has not had any violations.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated M.G.L. c.138, §34. The Commission **suspends the license for three (3) days of which three (3) days will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.**
