Purpose:	To notify Local Workforce Development Boards, One-Stop Career Center Operators and other local workforce partners of policy changes for the Workforce Training Fund Technical Assistance grants.
Background:	At the December 15, 2015 Workforce Training Fund Advisory Board meeting the members approved the following policy changes for the Workforce Training Fund Technical Assistance Grants effective January 15, 2016:
	 Grants will be awarded for a minimum of \$5,000 and a maximum of \$10,000
	 Grants will not exceed 6 months in length
	 Grants will only be awarded to organizations that are engaged in designing a training plan for a consortium of businesses
	At the same time we will begin accepting a new <u>Technical Assistance</u>
	<u>Application</u> . The new application is a streamlined, web-based form that can be accessed remotely from any computer and completed in multiple browser sessions

via a save-and-continue capability. The application includes the web form along with required attachments that can be uploaded to and submitted with the form.

The current PDF application will be accepted and existing grant policies honored up until Thursday January 14, 2016. Beginning Friday January 15, 2016, only the new web-based application will be accepted and the above changes will take effect.
