








Projected Change in Peak Hour Traffic due to Corridor Reconfiguration and Potential Development

















Cross Section at Rte. 79 Overpass – Existing Conditions (Average Storm Event)






Cross Section at Rte. 79 Overpass – Existing Conditions (100-year Storm Event)






Cross Section at Rte. 79 Overpass – Year 2070 (100-year Storm Event)






Cross Section at Rte. 79 Overpass – Year 2070 (100-year Storm Event)










