Transportation Network Security

Investments in security measures and operations

Enterprise Security Measures

- Real-time intelligence tools to monitor incidents and inform the EOC structure for full response
- Gathering FIFA intelligence from all host cities and stadiums
- Security Operations Center monitoring systems and security cameras with upgraded equipment at 11 key facilities

Transit

- Know Before You Go – prohibited items checks
- Queuing Operations and Security Screening procedures
- Trespassing Reduction Plan

Roadway

- Strategically located tow trucks for quick clearance of crashes/disabled vehicles
- Additional coverage of the Highway Assistance Program (HAP)

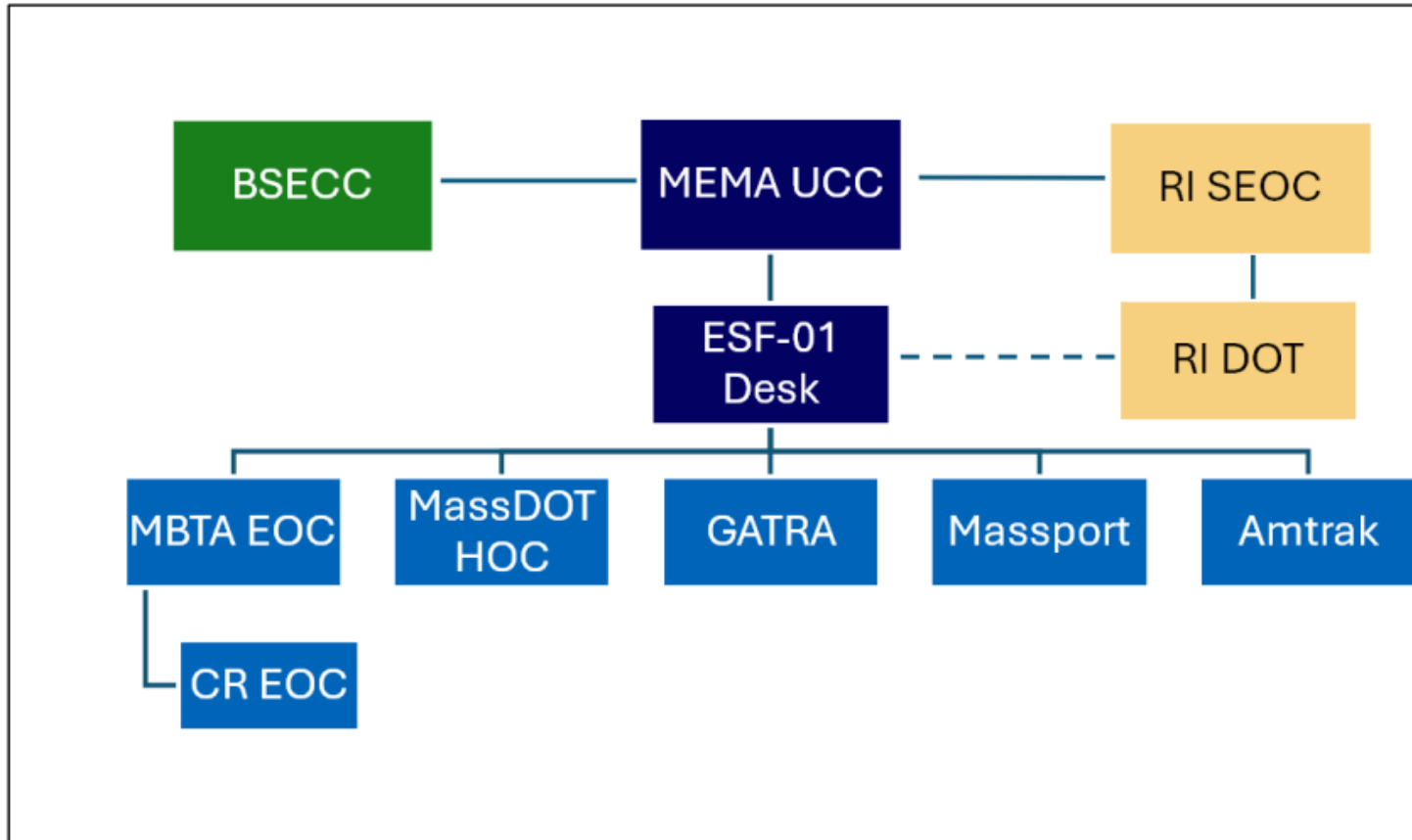

Emergency Preparedness

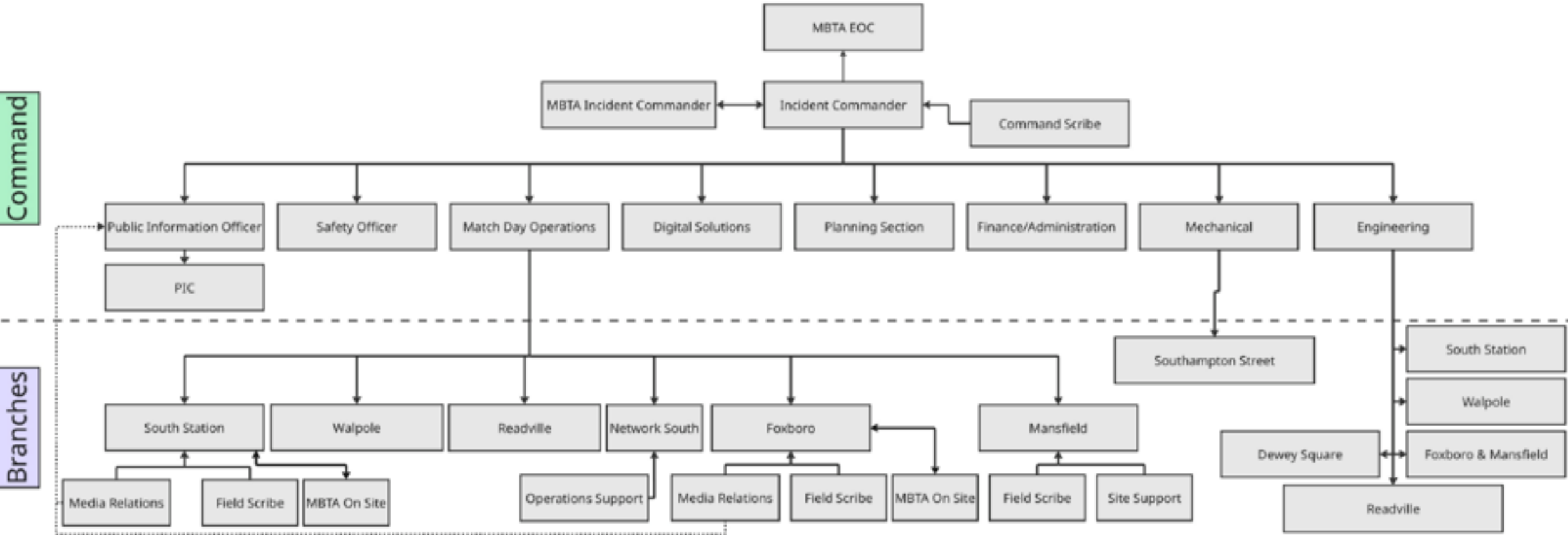
Public safety planning for the World Cup is one of the largest coordinated efforts ever undertaken in Massachusetts.

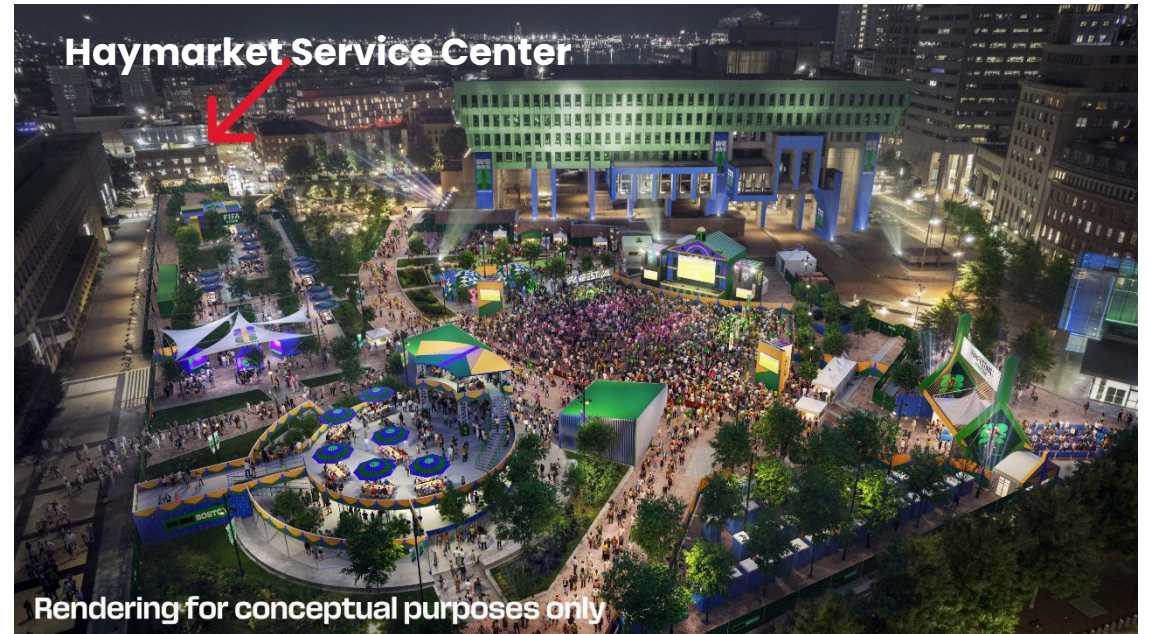
Mitigating Fan Watch Party Impacts

Real Time Updates for Traveling Public

Messaging

- Travel Times Boards, Go Time
- PCMS boards provide additional messaging to drivers
 - Heavy traffic messages, plan ahead messages
 - Supplement boards along Route 1 approaching Boston stadium to provide visual messaging for ADA parking
- Day of information on social, radio, and other media outlets

Mass511

- Real time travel times and delays for the four main routes to Boston Stadium

MBTA

- 2-way customer communication on X
- Know Before You Go – recommend signing up for MBTA GO App
- MBTA Go App & “Google Maps” real-time arrivals, delays, directions, and crowding

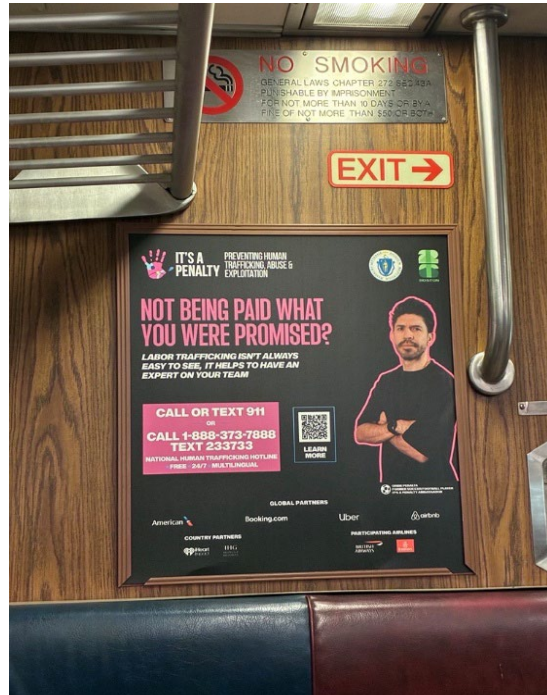

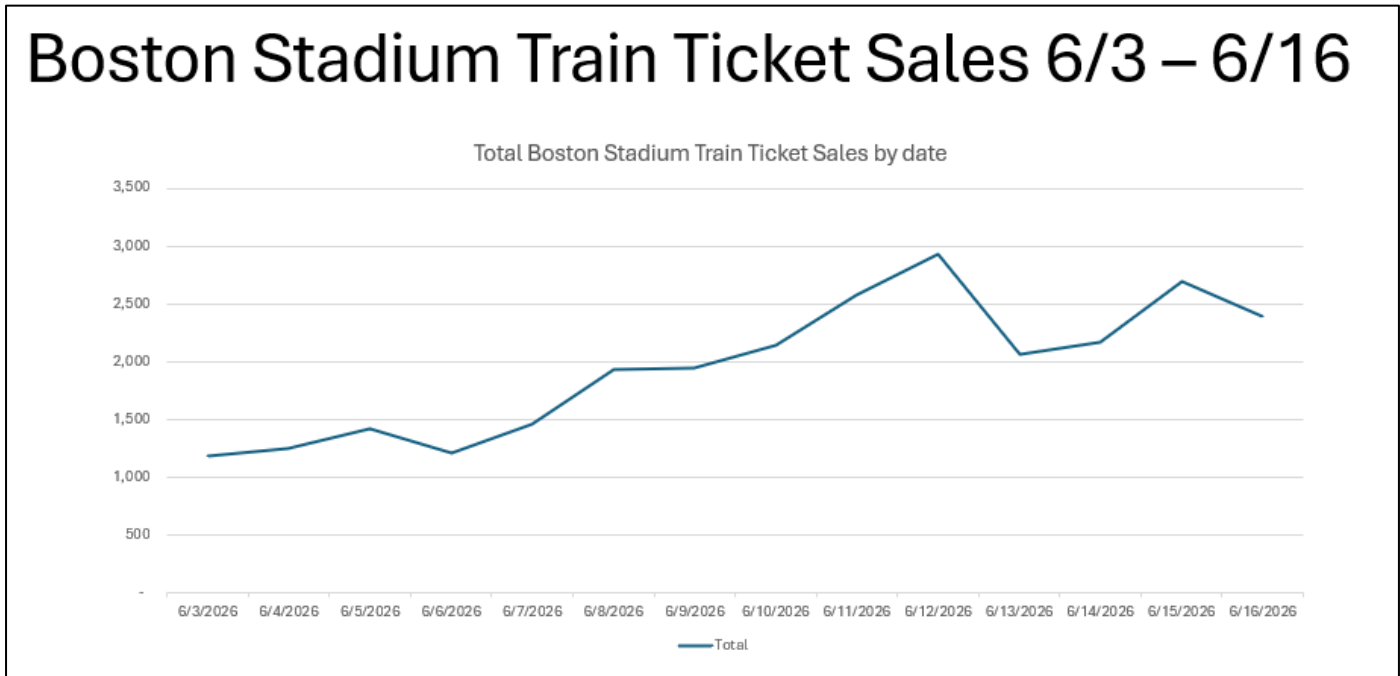
