- You must apply for these permits if your facility has a discharge that requires a permit under 314 CMR 5.00 and falls under one of the Standard Industrial Classification Codes. Any facility without remediation discharges outside of these SIC codes must apply for other groundwater discharge permits, as specified in 314 CMR 5.00.
- □ This presentation will take you screen by screen through the ePLACE online permitting application process.
