Workplace Safety and Health for the Public Sector Site Specific Targeting (SST)

Workplace safety and Health in state and local government agencies falls under the Massachusetts Department of Labor Standards, Workplace Safety and Health Program (WSHP). The following list identifies WSHP focused inspection sites based on injury rates.

- Crossing Guard (NAICS 922120 when Police; 6111 when school)
- Drinking Water, Sewage (NAICS 221310)
- Electric Power Distribution (NAICS 2211)
- Facility Management (NAICS 561210); school(6111); housing authority(925110)
- Firefighting (NAICS 922160)
- Healthcare and Social Services (NAICS 622, 623)
- Parks and Recreation; State Parks (NAICS 5617)
- Public Works: Highway Street Construction (NAICS 2373)
- Traffic Detail (NAICS 922120)
- K-12 Schools (NAICS 6111)
- Sewage treatment (NAICS 221320)

In the private sector, OSHA has a similar site-specific targeting (SST) list. This list identifies types of employers where injury rates are high.
