

10th Annual Yard Sign Design Contest

Contest Opens: January 5, 2026

Deadline for Entries: February 23, 2026

The Massachusetts Safe Routes to School (SRTS) Program's Yard Sign Design Contest is a way for students to use their creativity to help promote safe roads for people walking, biking, and rolling in their communities.

Here's how:

- Students create and submit a design for a yard sign with this year's theme: **NO-IDLING**
- Turning off vehicle engines when waiting is not only important for reducing pollution and making a healthier school environment, but it is also a law in Massachusetts prohibiting unnecessary engine idling for more than **five minutes**¹.
- Signs may be hand-drawn or created digitally in LANDSCAPE format.
- The four winning designs will be made into yard signs for distribution to SRTS partner schools around the Commonwealth (see winning designs from previous years below and on our [website](#)).

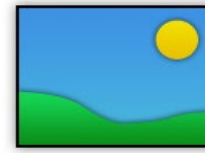

¹ Massachusetts state laws (M.G.L. Chapter 90, Sections 16A and 16B) and MassDEP's anti-idling regulation [310 CMR 7.11(1)(b)] prohibit unnecessary vehicle idling for more than five minutes. Guidelines and Eligibility Requirements

- The contest is open to students in **grades 2-8** that are enrolled in a Massachusetts SRTS partner school.
- Students may submit an 11 x 8 ½ hand-drawn version of the sign and/or a digital version (**landscape orientation is required**). A template is available on the last page.
- Submissions must **NOT** include any copyrighted photos, graphics, or slogans.
- **Multilingual signs are HIGHLY encouraged to reach as many people as possible.**
- Submissions must **NOT** include the SRTS or MassDOT logos. Please leave a small border at the bottom of the page for the SRTS Program to add the MassDOT and SRTS logos after.
- Please make sure designs are focused on this year's theme.
- The winning designs will be seen from a distance. Color and font size choices are important.
- Students may submit individual entries or work in a group.
- A parent/guardian must fill out and sign the form (see page 3) acknowledging all the contest guidelines outlined within this document. A school representative should also sign (if available).
 - Checking for spelling and grammar mistakes is highly recommended.
- A completed and signed form must be submitted with each drawing.
 - Please write the name(s)/grade(s) of the student(s) on the back of the drawing in case it gets separated from the registration form.

Selection of Winners: Winning entrants will be notified through the school representative listed on the registration forms. Once all designs have been submitted, a selection committee will determine up to four winners. Please note that submitted designs/artwork will not be returned to the school or student.

Schools with winning entrant(s) may be asked to participate in, and/or host, a recognition event. The Massachusetts SRTS Program will coordinate and manage event logistics.

Massachusetts SRTS, through MassDOT, reserves the right to edit or reject any yard sign entered in the contest. All entrants (through the school official as well as parents/guardians) agree that by submitting their entries in the contest, they give up the right to any compensation for their possible use as a public service announcement or on any other media, social media, news outlet, printed publication, or any additional viewing source. The winning entrants agree to the use of their photos on social media and other such outlets owned or operated by MassDOT and their affiliated organizations and offices. By submitting an entry(ies), the school representative or parent/guardian agrees that they have complied with the school's privacy and media appearance policy for students and staff. *Please note that Massachusetts SRTS will add MassDOT and SRTS logos to all winning yard signs.*
