

Yard Sign Design Contest



The Massachusetts Safe Routes to School's Yard Sign Design Contest is a way for students to use their creativity to help promote safe roads for cyclists and pedestrians in their communities.

Here's how: Students will create and submit a design for a yard sign that stresses the importance of anti-idling around school. The focus should be on reducing pollution and making a healthier environment around the school by encouraging parents and caregivers to turn off vehicle engines when waiting to drop off or pick up a child at school¹. Signs may be hand drawn or created digitally. Four winners will be chosen and the winning designs will be made into yard signs for distribution to our partner schools around the Commonwealth.

Contest Submission Guidelines and Eligibility Requirements:

- Participating schools must be a Massachusetts Safe Routes to School partner school
- The contest is open to grades 2-8
- Students must be enrolled in a Massachusetts Public School
- Students may submit an 8 ½ x 11 hand drawn version of the sign and/or a digital version
- Yard signs must not include any copyrighted photos or slogans
- Yard signs must not include the Safe Routes to School or MassDOT logos
- Students may submit individual entries or work in a group

Submission Rules: A school official must sign the registration form for any posters submitted by a student/s within their school. A parent/guardian must also sign the form acknowledging all of the contest guidelines outlined within this document.

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¹ Massachusetts state laws (M.G.L. Chapter 90, Sections 16A and 16B) and MassDEP's anti-idling regulation [310 CMR 7.11(1) (b)] prohibit unnecessary vehicle idling for more than five minutes. Yard Sign Design Contest Terms & Conditions

Submissions must be received by March 16, 2019 and can be emailed to Keith.Doty@dot.state.ma.us or mailed to 211 Congress Street, Suite 210, Boston, MA 02110

Selection of Winners: Upon selection, winners will be notified through the school official listed on the registration form. Once all posters have been submitted, a selection committee will determine up to four winners. Winners will be notified within two weeks following the submission deadline. Winners may share one side of a yard sign.

The winning applicant(s') school may be asked to participate in, and host, a recognition event. The Massachusetts Safe Routes to School Program will coordinate and manage event logistics.

Massachusetts Safe Routes to School, through MassDOT, reserves the right to edit or even reject any yard sign entered into the contest. All entrants (through the school official as well as parents and guardians) agree that by submitting their entries in the contest, they give up the right to any compensation for their possible use as a public service announcement or on any other media, social media, news outlets, printed publications, or any additional viewing source. The winning entrants agree to their photos being used on social media and other such outlets owned or operated by MassDOT and their affiliated organizations and offices. By submitting an entry(ies) the school representative or parent/guardian agrees that they have complied with the school's privacy and media appearance policy for students and staff. Please note that Massachusetts Safe Routes to School will add MassDOT and Safe Routes to School logos to all winning yard signs.
