

4th Annual Yard Sign Design Contest

Distracted Driving

February 25, 2020 - May 1st, 2020 (deadline extended due to COVID-19)

The Massachusetts Safe Routes to School (SRTS) Program's Yard Sign Design Contest is a way for students to use their creativity to help promote safe roads for cyclists and pedestrians in their communities.

Here's how: Students create and submit a design for a yard sign that brings awareness to **distracted driving**. With the recent passing of hands-free legislation for electronics (<u>Mass. General Laws, Chapter 90 Section 13B</u>), we want the students to focus their designs on eliminating **distracted driving**, especially in and around school zones.

Signs may be hand drawn or created digitally. Four winners will be chosen, and the winning designs will be made into yard signs for distribution to SRTS partner schools around the Commonwealth. See below for winning designs from previous years.

Contest Submission Guidelines and Eligibility Requirements:

- Participating schools must be Massachusetts SRTS partners.
- The contest is open to students in grades 2-8.
- Students may submit an 8 ½ x 11 hand drawn version of the sign and/or a digital version. (landscape orientation is preferred)
- Yard signs must not include any copyrighted photos or slogans.
- Yard signs must NOT include the SRTS or MassDOT logos.
- Students may submit individual entries or work in a group.
- A school official must sign the registration form (page 3) for any posters submitted by a student/s within the school. A parent/guardian must also sign the form acknowledging all the contest guidelines outlined within this document.

Selection of Winners: Winning entrants will be notified through the school officials listed on their registration forms. Once all posters have been submitted, a selection committee will determine up to four winners. Winners will be notified within two weeks following the submission deadline. Winners may share one side of a yard sign. Please note that submitted signs will not be returned to the school or student.

Schools with winning entrant(s) may be asked to participate in, and host, a recognition event. The Massachusetts SRTS Program will coordinate and manage event logistics.

Massachusetts SRTS, through MassDOT, reserves the right to edit or reject any yard sign entered in the contest. All entrants (through the school official as well as parents and guardians) agree that by submitting their entries in the contest, they give up the right to any compensation for their possible use as a public service announcement or on any other media, social media, news outlet, printed publication, or any additional viewing source. The winning entrants agree to use of their photos on social media and other such outlets owned or operated by MassDOT and their affiliated organizations and offices. By submitting an entry(ies), the school representative or parent/guardian agrees that they have complied with the school's privacy and media appearance policy for students and staff. Please note that Massachusetts SRTS will add MassDOT and SRTS logos to all winning yard signs.
