
This Board's responsibility as the central administering body for selection of all designers for vertical building construction projects throughout the Commonwealth necessitated direct involvement in review and approval of the designer selection procedures for certain public agencies, including Mass. Technology Collaborative; Mass. Convention Center Authority; Massport; Department of Housing and Community Development; Massachusetts School Building Authority.

The Board had a busy and productive year. We trust our involvement in expediting the selection of designers will be beneficial to the Commonwealth in providing the necessary supplementary support needed for DCAMM's expanded workload.

The Board looks forward to continued cooperation and assistance in achieving the Commonwealth's goal of providing well designed public buildings at reasonable cost. Our efforts were eminently supported by the DSB office staff. The staff has endeavored to provide a timely and effective response to the needs of the Board, and have at all times given the highest priority to expediting the processing of new requests for designer selection.

In compliance with the General Laws and past practices, this Report will be distributed to the State House library and various architectural and engineering organizations, and will be made available to the public upon request. ## EXECUTIVE NARRATIVE

The Board acted on twenty-four (24) projects in this calendar year. There are two (2) additional 2016 projects to be scheduled in 2017.

The procedures employed to select finalists for each project were in accordance with Chapter 7C of the Massachusetts General Laws, and were tailored to maintaining the goals of the Board, namely to:

- (a) *ensure that the commonwealth receives the highest quality design services for all its building projects;*
- (b) *provide for increased confidence in the procedures followed in the procurement of design and design related services;*
- (c) *promote consistency in the methods of procurement of design and design related services;*
- (d) *foster effective broad-based participation in public work within the design professions; and*
- (e) *provide safeguards for the maintenance of the integrity of the system for the procurement of designers' services within the commonwealth.*

## **OTHER SIGNIFICANT ISSUES**

### **I EXEMPTION FROM THE JURISDICTION OF THE DESIGNER SELECTION BOARD**

In accordance with Chapter 7C, Section 46 of the General Laws, this Board is authorized to approve Designer Selection Procedures for certain public agencies i.e. the Mass. Convention Center Authority; Mass. Technology Collaborative; Massachusetts Port Authority; Department of Housing and Community Development; Massachusetts School Building Authority. Upon approval of such procedures, the respective agency is empowered to perform its own designer selections for two years. If they do not meet with the Board's approval, (specified in writing) they are prohibited from selecting any Designer firms until they have the Boards approval.

**III LEGAL MATTERS**

**A. Interpretations of Chapter Seven M.G.L.**

From time to time, the Board receives inquiries, by telephone, by mail and by email, asking for our interpretations of the laws governing designer selection procedures. The questions may come from city or town officials, members of designer selection bodies, or practicing architects and engineers.

The Executive Director and his staff attempt to research the applicable laws, and particularly to find reasonably similar cases in the Board's files.

Up until a few years ago, the Bureau of Labor and Industries was available for answering such questions, but that practice has ceased. As a replacement, the Office of the Attorney General, Fair Labor & Business Practices has assumed an interpreter's role.

The Office of General Counsel of the DCAMM is a tireless source of help with legal questions on the designer selection laws, and although they have a heavy workload they attempt to always give a timely response.

Another valuable source of information in these matters has been the Inspector General's Office.

The Governor's Office is preparing their Capital Budget for FY17, which will possibly include some larger DCAMM projects in addition to House Doctor contracts. The larger projects will not happen until the next fiscal year beginning on July 1, 2016. There will also likely be a continued flow of Charter School projects.

The Executive Office of Administration and Finance not DCAMM or DSB will be selecting the Executive Director.

Ripples Group will not continue with the next phase until the Executive Director is hired.

George Matthews, DCAMM General Counsel, Jack Keleher, DCAMM Director of Small Projects Team and Liz Minnis, DCAMM Deputy Commissioner were present to explain projects that will be advertised for the Small Projects Team. After a brief discussion, the Board and DCAMM agreed to the following to read within the advertisement for the Small Project House Doctors:

**For the Estimated Construction Cost and added to the Introduction Section:**

Less than \$10,000,000 per project. Projects of various amounts (i.e. less than \$1,000,000 and up to \$10,000,000) will be awarded pursuant to this advertisement. Firms of all sizes are strongly encouraged to apply.

**Footnote to read on Page 2 of the advertisement:**

Projects involving complex study and/or programming, or projects wherein sound engineering principles may dictate involve a longer schedule for study/design or construction (particularly any projects involving a building addition) will require further approval of the Designer Selection Board prior to their inclusion in this House Doctor Contract.

- **Discussion: Legislation for “Schematic Design” – June 8, 2016**

The Board met with representatives from DCAMM to discuss the amendment to Chapter 7C §59 Acts of 2015 that was passed in November 2015 regarding Schematic Design fee added to the advertisement.

- **Discussion: Designer Fee Schedule – August 31, 2016**

Tabitha Harkin, DCAMM Project Manager met with the Board to discuss the Strategic Assessment of the Designer Fee Schedule. DCAMM hired a consultant, City Point Partners to analyze the designer fee schedule. Tabitha will meet with the Board at the end of October to discuss Task 3 – Evaluate phases of the project life cycle/design fee allocations for each and Task 4 – Present proposed new structure and integration with key manuals and design contracts. As of the end of December no further discussion since August 31, 2016.
