## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS

Pursuant to M.G.L. c. 112, § 263 and M.G.L. c. 30A, the Division of Professional Licensure (DPL) will hold two public hearings relative to proposed regulations at 230 CMR 12.00 - 17.00. The proposed regulations pertain to the licensure and oversight of private occupational schools and sales representatives.

Effective August 1, 2012, DPL assumed responsibility for the licensing and regulation of private occupational schools (also known as "proprietary schools") and sales representatives, pursuant to M.G.L. c. 112, § 263. Previously, private occupational schools and sales representatives were licensed and regulated by the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE). The proposed regulations will replace DESE regulations at 603 CMR 3.00.

The proposed regulations establish the licensure application process and set forth procedures for DPL approvals, denials, and disciplinary action. Additionally, the proposed regulations establish qualifications for licensure and standards of practice as they relate to sales representatives, instructors, student enrollment agreements, record keeping, disclosures, representations, advertisements, and the general operation of private occupational schools.

Interested parties will be given an opportunity to present testimony orally or in writing at the hearings.
