Trouble with faxing the CANS consent form	A CANS user may mistakenly use his or her organization's fax cover sheet when faxing a CANS consent form. The software that MassHealth uses to manage faxed consent forms <b>CANNOT</b> read your organization's fax cover sheet. If you try to fax a CANS consent using your organization's coversheet, that consent form <i>will not</i> be registered.	You must use the fax cover sheet that you can print out from the CBHI application. It will automatically print out with member and provider information on it.
