TO: ALL HOSPITALS

IN RE: CHARGES OF HOSPITALS FOR SERVICES UNDER THE WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION ACT.

Gentlemen:

Each hospital is reminded that its "Statement of Reimbursable Cost" is to be filed with the Department of Public Health no later than March 31, 1952. This Department is informed that the necessary blanks have already been furnished each hospital by the Department of Public Health.

The Industrial Accident Board reserves the right to determine the per diem rate for workmen's compensation cases for such hospitals as fail to file the aforementioned statement within the prescribed time.
