Notice of Public Hearings and Public Comment Period: Emergency Regulations Requiring a White Shark Special Permit to Conduct Certain Activities around White Sharks

Under the provisions of M.G.L. c. 30A § 2and pursuant to the authority found at M.G.L. c. 130 § 80, the Division of Marine Fisheries (DMF) and the Marine Fisheries Advisory Commission have scheduled a public hearing and public comment period to provide an opportunity to accept comment related to permanently codifying emergency regulations – enacted June 5, 2015 - restricting activity around white sharks.

- 1. <u>White Shark Special Permit Requirements (322 CMR 6.37).</u> DMF will accept comments on the following emergency regulation:
 - a. It is unlawful for any person to attract or attempt to attract a white shark within the waters under the jurisdiction of the Commonwealth without having been issued a "white shark special permit" by DMF. This includes, but is not limited to, chumming for white sharks or towing decoys for white sharks.
 - b. It is unlawful for any person to capture, attempt to capture or perform intrusive research on or attempt to perform intrusive research on a white shark within the waters under the jurisdiction of the Commonwealth without having been issued a "white shark special permit" by DMF.
 - c. These rules do not restrict the presence of persons on the water actively conducting lawful commercial or recreational fishing activities.
