CIRCULAR LETTER NO. 193

TO: ALL INSURANCE COMPANIES, ALL SELF-INSURERS, AND WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION AGENTS OF DEPARTMENTS OF THE COMMONWEALTH AND COUNTIES, CITIES, TOWNS, AND DISTRICTS SUBJECT TO THE WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION LAW (GENERAL LAWS, CHAPTER 152, AS AMENDED).

Please be advised that the Industrial Accident Board has voted to establish the following procedure in reference to the payment of compensation under a Single Member or Reviewing Board decision.

In those instances where an employee is represented by an attorney and a Single Member or Reviewing Board orders the payment of compensation the insurer, self-insurer, or public employer, shall make the check payable to the employee, only, but shall mail the check to the office of the employee's attorney.
