CIRCULAR LETTER NO. 122

TO: ALL INSURANCE COMPANIES, ALL SELF-INSURERS, AND  
WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION AGENTS OF DEPARTMENTS OF  
THE COMMONWEALTH AND COUNTIES, CITIES, TOWNS  
AND DISTRICTS SUBJECT TO THE WORKMEN'S COMPENSA-  
TION ACT (GENERAL LAWS, CHAPTER 152, AS AMENDED).

IN RE: CHARGES OF HOSPITALS UNDER THE  
JURISDICTION OF THE VETERANS'  
ADMINISTRATION AND OTHER FEDERAL  
AGENCIES FOR SERVICES UNDER THE  
WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION ACT.

The Industrial Accident Board is informed that the  
Federal per diem rate for hospitals coming under the  
jurisdiction of the Veterans' Administration and other  
Federal agencies is \$23.00 per day, effective July 1,  
1960. Kindly make this correction on hospital lists.

It is to be noted that this \$23.00 rate is not all-  
inclusive, and certain charges such as laboratory,  
X-ray, transfusions, etc., are billed in addition.
