TO: ALL INSURERS, SELF-INSURERS, COMPENSATION AGENTS OF POLITICAL SUB-DIVISIONS UNDER G. L. CHAPTER 152, SECTION 75, AS AMENDED, HOSPITALS AND DISTRICT #5 MASSACHUSETTS STATE NURSES ASSOCIATION.


The Industrial Accident Board have voted that effective July 1, 1953, the per diem rate of compensation for special duty nurses in attendance on Workmen's Compensation Cases in District #5 of the Massachusetts State Nurses Association will be approved as follows:

\$12.50 per eight hour duty. .
\$18.75 per twelve hour duty. .
\$19.75 per twenty hour duty. .
For two patients any eight hour period \$18.75. .

District #5, to which the foregoing applies, comprises Suffolk County, Norfolk County and all of Middlesex County with the exception of Ashby, Townsend, Pepperell, Shirley, Dunstable, Groton, Ayer, Littleton, Boxboro, Stov, Hudson, Marlboro, Ashland, Hopkinton, Holliston, Medway, Bellingham and Franklin.

No additional allowance is made for board of such special nurses.
