

Henry W. DiCarlo, MM, MA

Mr. Henry DiCarlo is a Loss Prevention, Safety and Security professional and educator with over 35 years' experience in all aspects of organizational asset protection and risk management. He has worked for several prominent Massachusetts businesses, including; New Balance Athletic Shoe, The Stride Rite Corporation, First Security Services Corporation and Filenes. For many years, he actively managed large Workers' Compensation programs. More recently, for 7 years, he served as the campus Safety Coordinator for Curry College in Milton. In 2010 Henry became a full-time faculty member of Massasoit Community College. He is currently a tenured Assistant Professor and Chair of the Criminal Justice Department. In addition to his teaching responsibilities he maintains a small Loss Prevention and Security Consulting practice.

First appointed to the Health Care Services Board in 1991 as the Employer Representative, Mr. DiCarlo has served as the Vice-Chair since 1999. He also Chairs the Board's Complaint Sub-committee.
