I represent the Massachusetts Division of Insurance ("Division") with regard to the above captioned investigation.

The Division has reviewed information pertaining to a contract in use prior to the issuance of your public insurance adjuster license. It appears that a small portion of the language within the contract may have violated M.G.L. c.175, § 162R. The penalty for each and every violation of M.G.L. c. 175, § 162R(a) is a fine of not more than \$1,000 and license suspension or revocation.

In light of the fact that you are now duly licensed, the Division proposes to settle this matter without a fine if you agree to cease and desist from the above-alleged conduct. This will be a reportable administrative action. If these terms are acceptable kindly sign the letter below and return to me. Your public insurance adjuster license remains active and in good standing.

Although this correspondence does not constitute the required statutory notice of a public hearing, if this matter is not resolved by March 31, 2017, the Division intends to file an Order to Show Cause.
