Project examples include:

- Dry cleaners Replace perchloroethylene with professional wet cleaning.
- **Auto body shops** Replace solvent-based paint gun washers with water-based alternatives.
- Child care facilities Introduce safer cleaning and sanitizing products.
- **Gymnasium**s Replace foam pit cubes that contain flame retardants with safer products.



- Restaurants Replace traditional sanitizers with safer options.
- **Breweries** Reduce caustic cleaners and acid rinses in clean-in-place processes.
- **Mortuarie**s Introduce options to formaldehyde.
- **Bathtub refinishers** Replace methylene chloride with a mechanical stripping process.

Program funding is limited and submitting an application is no guarantee that a grant will be awarded.
