APPLICATION PROCEDURE FOR PROBLEM ANIMAL CONTROL PERMIT

Background:

Problem Animal Control (PAC) Agents are private individuals licensed by the Massachusetts Division of Fisheries and Wildlife (MassWildlife) to assist the public with wildlife species (listed below) that are sick or injured, causing property damage, or endangering human health and safety.

Wildlife species authorized under this permit:

Striped skunk, muskrat, raccoon, weasel, red and gray fox, porcupine, rats, mice, voles*, moles, red, gray or flying squirrels, opossum, chipmunk, European rabbit, cottontail rabbit, woodchuck, snapping turtle, pigeon, house sparrow, starling and bat*. * Certain species of voles and bats are not authorized – refer to 321 CMR 10:00.

Prior to sending in this application, PAC applicants must:

- 1. Complete a mandatory trapper education course call Hunter Education at (508) 389 –7823, or check the course schedule online under "Education & Events". *Note: this step is only required for those individuals not yet assigned a trap registration number.
- 2. Obtain a Trap Registration Certificate/Number (obtained upon completion of course).
- 3. Obtain a valid trapping license.
- 4. Pass a written exam that includes questions on biology, handling, capture techniques, animal welfare, diseases and parasites, statutes and regulations and is based on, but not limited to, materials in the PAC Handbook.
 - (a) To obtain a handbook, send a check made payable to Comm. of MA DFW for \$15.00 to the address below.
 - (b) To make an appointment for the PAC exam, call the Headquarters at (508) 389-6300 or the closest District office http://www.mass.gov/eea/agencies/dfg/dfw/about-masswildlife/district-offices.html

Application process:

Mail your application to the address below. The fee for a Problem Animal Control Permit is \$100 annually. Once your application is accepted, you will be authorized to purchase your permit from your home or any license vendor through the MassFishHunt online license system http://www.mass.gov/eea/agencies/dfg/licensing/

After receiving a permit, PAC Agents must:

- 1. Register and tag all traps.
 - (a) Traps must have a valid registration number embedded or cut into the trap.
 - (b) Traps must have a metal tag attached bearing the owner's name, town, and registration number.
- 2. Renew permit annually. PAC permits are valid from the time of purchase until December 31.
- 3. Submit an annual report.
 - (a) Annual reports must include all activity conducted under this permit.
 - (b) Annual report forms will be provided by the Division.
 - (c) Reports must be submitted to the Division on a yearly basis no later than January 31.
 - (d) Report forms must be available for inspection by an Environmental Police Officer or MassWildlife officials.
 - (e) Failure to submit an annual report or provide required information, or making false statements is cause for suspension, revocation, or non-renewal of the PAC permit.
