NOTE: Claims of award of Silver Star, Bronze Star, or Medal of Honor and claims of membership in the Legion of Valor are verified by the Massachusetts Department of Veterans' Services. I certify that I am the surviving spouse of the deceased veteran that I have indicated above, that I have not remarried, and that, if a Veterans' Plate is issued to me, it will be registered to a vehicle owned and principally used by me.
