Background: The National Association of State Workforce Agencies (NASWA) teamed up with LinkedIn, the world's largest professional network, to connect U.S. employers with job seekers. This collaboration connected the states' job banks to LinkedIn through NASWA's tool that collects national job openings, the National Labor Exchange (NLx).

As part of the new collaboration, NASWA and LinkedIn agreed that NLx state job bank openings would be available to all LinkedIn users. Additionally, LinkedIn agreed to provide state agencies with training curriculum on effective online job searching and networking. Networking has always been a key component of job search and today, online networking has become the new forum to amplify one's chances of finding the right match.

Training and tools developed under this partnership agreement provide workforce system staff with information on how to best assist job seekers to effectively use LinkedIn for online career networking. The goal is for State and Local staff to be up-to-date with today's job seekers and recruitment processes with better outcomes for the customer.

LinkedIn used materials straight from local areas and compiled a consistent training tool.
