## **DCR Pedestrian Advisory: New Charles River Dam Pedestrian Walkway**

**WHAT:** On Monday, October 30, 2017, and continuing through Friday, November 17, 2017, the Department of Conservation and Recreation (DCR) will implement a closure of the pedestrian walkway over the New Charles River Dam in the City of Boston to facilitate maintenance work at the facility. Signage will be clearly posted, and pedestrians are advised to plan an alternate route, such as using the North Washington Street Bridge.
