Questions about child support and service? We can help.

The Child Support Enforcement Division of the Department of Revenue (DOR) provides support to military service members and veterans with child support cases.

Our goal is to help parents manage their child support orders.

 Every child support case is different, but these are just a few ways that we can assist you:



Change Income Withholding

If your child support payments are deducted from your civilian paycheck, we can help you transfer that income withholding order to your military pay.



Ask for a Modification

If you're transitioning to active duty, you may make less money than you did as a civilian. We can help you ask the court to modify your child support payments. Keep in mind that only the court can decide what your child support order should be.



Manage Past-Due Child Support

Depending on your situation, we may be able to let you pay less past-due child support to the Commonwealth.



Lower Interest and Penalties

If you owe interest or penalties on past-due child support, we may be able to help reduce or remove the charges.



Set Up a Payment Agreement

If you receive needs-based benefits like Chapter 115 Veterans' Benefits, we can work with you to set up a payment agreement for past-due child support so you can keep receiving your benefits and avoid penalties.
