Dear Mr. Wattendorf:

This Notice to Proceed is provided by the Massachusetts Department of Conservation and Recreation ("Department") as formal authorization to proceed with the above-referenced contract ("Contract"). The work will include the work as described in the Contract Documents. This Notice to Proceed is effective as of the date signed below and is provided on a not-to-exceed basis, utilizing the total Contract cost of \$2,181,610.00 which reflects cost of the base bid renovations to the rink (\$1,981,610.00) plus Options #1 (\$100,000.00) and #2 (\$100,000.00)..

The contract scope entails installing one (1) complete locker room addition with five (5) locker rooms, ADA compliant bathrooms, showers, emergency exits, spectator seating and parking, new Zamboni room, full set of ADA compliant dasher boards around the ice surface and a complete fire alarm system.

All work to be completed no later than June 30, 2018 and no additional work shall be undertaken with written approval prior to commencement. Further, it is critical that the construction be executed in such a manner to not impact rink operations. The rink is open to public and fully operational from September 15, 2017 to March 18, 2018 and all construction work should be coordinated with these facility operations.
