Subject: Psych Armor and Veterans Program Training Partnership

Purpose: To notify Local Workforce Development Boards, One-Stop Career Center

Operators and partner staff of a new training partnership between Psych Armor

and the Veterans Program.

Background: As a part of promoting the Veterans Program and generating additional training to

support Career Center's understanding of military culture, we have created a partnership with the non-profit organization <u>Psych Armor</u>. Psych Armor offers multi-course programs designed to help a wide range of organizations better

understand military culture and Veterans programs.

The Psych Armor trainings are baseline-geared toward the Veteran population; much of the information provided can be used on a universal basis to understand the different Veteran groups within the career centers. With this new partnership, we will be able to accomplish the following:

- Conduct a 1.5-hour baseline training with all employees of the Career Centers in a group setting, at each individual Career Center. This training will provide a baseline for other trainings and with 100% participation from Career Center Staff will make the Department of Career Services the first State Agency to become a "Veteran Certified Organization" through Psych Armor.
- All career centers will receive login credentials for employees to access the Massachusetts Psych Armor site, (being designed by Psych Armor specifically

for Massachusetts) to access additional training based on their current job title (BSR, Employment Counselor).

Psych Armor will build a customized metric system for tracking training. Most training videos run between 15 and 20 minutes and are quite entertaining and informative.
