This application must be received by the Department at least 10 calendar days before the opening of any flea market, either indoor or outdoor, craft show, antique show, coin show, stamp show, comic book show, fair and any similar show, whether held regularly or of a temporary nature and at which more than one vendor displays for sale or sells tangible personal property subject to tax. A Registration Certificate will be sent five calendar days before the activity dates indicated in this Registration Application. A Registration Application must be filed for each location and a Promoter's Report must be filed for every calendar month of operation.
