










Deaths by Race and Hispanic Ethnicity




Confirmed Opioid-Related Overdose Death Rates, All Intents, by Race and Hispanic Ethnicity

Technical Notes

- Opioids include heroin, illicitly manufactured fentanyl, opioid-based prescription painkillers, and other unspecified opioids.
- 2017 and 2018 death data are preliminary and subject to updates. Case reviews of deaths are evaluated and updated on an ongoing basis. A large number of deaths have yet to be assigned final cause-of-death codes. The information presented in this report <u>only</u> includes confirmed cases. Data updated on 4/8/2019.
- Beginning with the May 2017 report, DPH started reporting opioid-related deaths for all intents, which includes unintentional/undetermined and suicide.
