



## DPH/Bureau of Substance Abuse Services Licensed Addiction Treatment Beds and Enrollment February 2019




ATS programs provide inpatient detoxification to persons with addictive disorders who are dependent on medications or illicit drugs and are at risk of experiencing physical withdrawal.



CSS programs provide short-term post detoxification stabilization services to persons with addictive disorders who are no longer at risk for withdrawal.



TSS programs provide intermediate residential support services for people who need a safe and structured environment to support their recovery process after detoxification. These programs are designed to transition individuals from acute treatment services to residential rehabilitation.



(Inclusive of Recovery Home, Social Model and Therapeutic Community residential models.) Community based long-term residential treatment with services designed to support persons in early phases of recovery from addiction to gain skills to maintain their recovery and live independently.
