



Statement of Intent to meet shade requirement

I understand that my system does not meet the DOER shading standards of 80% Solar Access Value for the MLP Solar Rebate Program. I intend to meet the requirement by agreeing to the following:

- I acknowledge that I am proceeding with the Rebate Application at my own risk,
- I am submitting a detailed, itemized quote or plan from a tree-cutting service, that describes the planned work. There will be enough detail to give program administrators a reasonable expectation that the PV system will meet the shade requirements after the work is completed,
- I will be removing trees and/or other obstacles that block the underperforming panels of the system as detailed in the above-referenced plan,
- When I submit my completion documents, I will submit an updated shade report/analysis that meets the 80% standard,
- I will also submit the paid invoice from the tree removal company along with my completion documents.

For applications that do not meet the shade requirement

The DOER requires a signed statement of intent to meet the shade requirement and a detailed description from a tree-cutting service of proposed work. Both documents should be submitted with your initial paperwork to the MLP.

The itemized, dated tree-cutting quote or plan needs to include the following:

- Number of trees or branches that will be removed from the property.
- Location of tree on property (North, South, East, West)
- Tree height and species
- Description of tree removal's effect on system, meaning which plane and how many panels that will be affected by the removals.
