- Multi-lingual live response via call and text 24/7/365.
- No insurance necessary.
- Crisis identification and action when needed, follow-up within 48 hrs.
 - Dispatch mobile crisis intervention to a home or community-based location.
 - Includes connection to 911 for emergency rescue if needed.
- Clinical assessment, triage, and warm hand-off to a provider with appropriate expertise.
- Follow-up to ensure connection is made.



Community Behavioral Health Center (CBHC)

 Crisis evaluation, de-escalation, and triage to appropriate next level of care on-site or in home and community-based locations via mobile crisis intervention teams (MCI).
 Covered for all with or without insurance.

24/7/365

 Community Crisis Stabilization beds, a 24-hour diversionary level of care for individuals in crisis who don't require an inpatient psychiatric setting. Available to all MassHealth members. May be available to those with commercial insurance.

24/7/365

- Urgent and ongoing behavioral health outpatient care and connection:
 - Same day evaluation, assessment, group therapy, and peer support.
 - Same or next day appointments.
 - Extended hours.

Monday - Friday 8 a.m. - 8 p.m. Weekends 9 a.m. - 5 p.m.

- Evaluation and urgent medications for treatment of BH (or psychiatric) conditions and addiction.
- Care coordination and referral to additional needed services.
- Available to all MassHealth members.
 May be available to those with commercial insurance.



Behavioral Health Urgent Care: mass.gov/BHroadmap

- Available to all MassHealth members. May be available to those with commercial insurance.
- Same/next day appointments for diagnostic evaluation for new clients and urgent appointments for existing clients.
- Urgent psychopharmacology evaluation for initiation of medication for addiction treatment 72 hours post-assessment.
- Non-urgent appointments available within 14 calendar days.
- Extended hours: 8 extra hours weekdays, two 4-hr weekend blocks monthly.
