#### **Licensing for Eyelash Businesses**

The subcommittee discussed different approaches for licensing eyelash businesses. The subcommittee asked Mr. Lawless to check with agency enforcement personnel to outline an inspection and approval process for eyelash businesses.

The subcommittee concluded that there should be a standalone registration for eyelash businesses. Mr. Lawless said this could be a challenge administratively, but he would explore options on creating an approval process and a way for the public to access a list of approved businesses. The subcommittee also concluded that any eyelash business would be subject to all aesthetics salon requirements in 240 CMR 3.00.

#### **Enforcement of Current Requirements**

The subcommittee advised Mr. Lawless that current requirements of needing an aesthetics or cosmetologist license to provide eyelash extensions should be enforced until any official changes are made.
