The Massachusetts Clean Auto Repair (MassCAR) Program

What is MassCAR?

The Massachusetts Office of Technical Assistance (OTA) created the Massachusetts Clean Auto Repair (MassCAR) Program to provide environmental training and resources for auto body and repair shops. The program is designed to help you:

- Understand and achieve compliance with environmental, health and safety (EHS) requirements.
- Learn about and implement pollution prevention and other best management practices.

MassCAR consists of an environmental and compliance guidance document and OTA will be offering free trainings to auto body and repair shops. The MassCAR guidance includes:

- The **MassCAR checklist** is a summary of actions you can take to ensure that requirements are followed and show your shop's good faith efforts to stay in compliance while protecting your workers and the environment.
- The **MassCAR fact sheets** include detailed information about key auto body and repair topics identified by the project partners. These fact sheets are intended to provide you with more information, benefits, possible obstacles, and steps forward for implementing each topic outlined on the fact sheet.
- The **MassCAR Environmental Achievement Statement** is a downloadable self-certification document that you can use to advertise and celebrate your environmental practices.

Shops that provide feedback or participate in trainings will receive a MassCAR certificate to acknowledge their efforts and contributions to this program and the environment.
