




Average Streamflow Conditions – June-Aug. 2020




Average Streamflow Conditions – Dec. 2020 - Feb. 2021




Average Streamflow Conditions – March-May 2021




7-Day Avg. – Ipswich River – Northeastern MA

7-Day Avg. – Housatonic River – Western MA












Groundwater Conditions – late May 2021




