







Above Normal Precipitation in Massachusetts, especially Southeast











3 and 6 Month Percent of Normal



Last 3 Months


November 01, 2022 to January 31, 2023






Last 6 Months

February Precipitation So Far (Up to Feb 7)



Below normal precipitation for the first week of February









- Sunday: Dry and seasonable.





No clear signal for above or below average precipitation


High probability of above average temperatures




Outlook: February 14-20



Odds favor above average precipitation




High probability of above average temperatures




Outlook: February 18 - March 3
