## **NARRATIVE**

#### **General Description/Forest Composition/History:**

The harvest area is located in the town of Rutland on Whitehall Rd, adjacent to the MA Central Rail Trail. It consists of white pine/hardwood, red pine, and white pine/oak stands.

Tree species present in the overstory are white pine, Scots pine, red, black, and white oaks, red pine, pitch pine, red maple, paper birch, yellow birch, black cherry, and eastern hemlock. The understory consists of red maple, eastern white pine, black birch, red, black, and white oak, eastern hemlock and black cherry.

Tree of heaven is present on the rail trail in the harvest area.

The soils are excessively well drained.

#### **Site Selection:**

The primary goal of the watershed forest management program is to create and maintain a forest that provides high quality drinking water to current users and future generations. A healthy and resilient forest is comprised of diverse native tree and shrub species and multiple age classes of trees.

This area was chosen because it is a good site to expand the pine/oak barrens on Whitehall Rd. This type of habitat is relatively rare in central Massachusetts and supports many rare species. It is characterized by overstory pitch pine and oak and is relatively open. The habitat is fire dependent. DWSP's goal is to maintain the habitat that will be created by this harvest with mechanical mowing and/or prescribed fire.

#### **Silvicultural Objectives:**

The goal in these stands is to create a barren to expand recent pitch pine/oak barren that was established in 2020 on the other side of the MCRT. The overstory pitch pine and white oak that is present is more scattered than the area that was previously cut. That will result in some areas that appear more open after the harvest. All trees greater than 5 feet tall that are not pitch pine or white oak will be cut and removed.

#### **Cultural Resources:**

Standard practice dictates that every effort is made to avoid disturbing stone walls and other cultural resources.

#### Wildlife/Rare or Endangered Species:

Natural Heritage Endangered Species Program (NHESP) does not show any rare habitat within the harvest area.




