

Need to replace a lost or stolen disability placard? You may be able skip a trip to the RMV by obtaining the proper form online

To request a replacement disability placard, you will need your:

- Name
- Date of birth
- Social security number
- Disability Placard Number (if known)


There is no fee for a replacement disability placard. It takes 30 days to issue a new placard and after a replacement placard is requested, the original placard is cancelled.

1. Type mass.gov/RMV into the address bar of your browser.




Then press the **[Enter]** key on your keyboard to visit the **Massachusetts Registry of Motor Vehicles** webpage.

2. Scroll down the webpage to the green **What would you like to do?** banner, then click the **Disability Plates and Placards** button.

3. Scroll down the webpage to the blue **What would you like to do?** banner, then click the **Replace your disability placard** button.



4. Review the information on this webpage, then scroll down the page to the **Downloads** heading. Click the **Request for Replacement Placard** PDF hyperlink to open the form.

5. Print and complete the **Request for Replacement Placard** form.
