The Beverly Retirement Board is seeking qualified applicants for the Fifth Member of the Beverly Contributory Retirement Board. In accordance with M.G.L. Chapter 32 section 20(4)(b), the 5th member shall not be an employee, retiree, or official of the City of Beverly and shall be chosen by the other four board members, for a 3 year term commencing on the date of hire.

Beverly Retirement Board members serve as fiduciaries of the Beverly Contributory Retirement Board and are responsible for overseeing the administration of the retirement benefits to over 1, 333 active and retired members and approximately \$174 million in pension assets. Board members perform their duties solely in the interest of its members and beneficiaries in accordance with Massachusetts General Laws, the rules and regulations promulgated by the Public Employee Retirement Administration Commission (PERAC) and the rules and regulations adopted by the Board as approved by PERAC. The successful candidate must be available to attend Board meetings once a month (typically the last Thursday of the month at 6 p.m.) Board Members are paid a yearly stipend of \$3,000.
