Procedure For Changing Public Water Supply Classification (Year 2000 Printing)

Background and Rationale

This policy is adopted to standardize the procedure to be followed to reclassify or declassify a public water system as community, nontransient-noncommunity, transient noncommunity, declassified or inactive.

Policy

In order to change the classification of a public water system or to declassify or inactivate a public water system, the following steps must be followed:

- The public water system must complete the public water system
 Declassification/Reclassification/Inactive request form and submit it to the appropriate DEP Regional Office.
- 2. DEP Regional staff will review the form, make a determination and notify the public water system in writing.
- 3. Any change in the classification or status or a public water system must be made in the Department's Water Quality Testing System (WQTS) by regional staff.
