## **Treatment For Radionuclide Removal**

Policy, SOP or Guideline #91-02

This policy is adopted to provide public water systems and the DWS with procedures for processing requests for approval of treatment for the removal of radionuclides from drinking water.

## **Policy**

It is the policy of the Division of Water Supply to promote radionuclide treatment techniques that do not produce a liquid or solid radioactive waste.

The following procedures shall be followed for Public Water Systems requiring treatment for radionuclide removal:

- The Division recommends treatment techniques that do not produce a liquid or solid radioactive
  Waste. The preferred accepted treatment methods are packed tower aeration (PTA) or diffused
  Bubble systems (DBS).
  - DWS will arrange coordination with DAQ for PWS seeking approval to use PTA (or DBS) as treatment technique.
- II. If the treatment method to be used will generate liquid or solid waste containing natural radioactivity, the applicant will be required to apply for a determination of need for a license from the Massachusetts DHW.
